Description of Type Design Change:

Installation of wing tip mounted emblem lights in accordance with FAA sealed DeVore Aviation Service Drawing No. 01000001.

Limitations and Conditions:

The approval of this change in type design applies basically to DC-10-10, -30, -30F, -40 only. This approval should not be extended to other aircraft of this model on which other previously approved modifications are incorporated unless it is determined by the installer that the interrelationship between this change and any of those other previously approved modifications will introduce no adverse effect upon the airworthiness of that aircraft. This determination should include consideration of significant changes in weight distribution such as an increase in the fixed disposable weight in the fuselage.

This certificate and the supporting data which is the basis for approval shall remain in effect until surrendered, suspended, revoked or a termination date is otherwise established by the Administrator of the Federal Aviation Administration.
